FUNERALS AND MEMORIAL SERVICES AT ST JOHN'S

St. John's is a serene and beautiful setting to honour the life of someone we love. It is available for funeral and memorial services, and maintains a beautiful garden for the interment of ashes after cremation. Services may vary from simple brief prayers for the deceased to a full choral requiem. The clergy of St John's are available to guide relatives through this time with help with funeral preparations.

SERVICES

Although the time immediately after a death is distressing, a Funeral or Memorial Service can also be consoling and reassuring. We are comforted by the faith we share and heartened by the opportunity to celebrate the life of the one now gone with the support of family and friends. Funerals and Memorial Services are an important reminder that we are not alone in our grief.

THE MEMORIAL GARDEN

The Memorial Garden adjoins the Parish Church and is available for the internment of ashes for those associated with St John's. Interments are separate and permanent. The names of those who have died are inscribed in a Memorial Book located in the Church porch and prayers are offered for the deceased on the nearest Sunday to the anniversary of their death. Memorial flowers may also be arranged for the anniversary. The garden offers a place of quiet repose for those who wish to sit quietly in the garden and remember those they love.

THE RUTHERFORD ROOM

The Rutherford Room is situated adjacent to the church and is a convenient venue that can hired for functions after services. The space looks out into beautiful gardens on two sides and is equipped with a professional kitchen. Information on hiring The Rutherford Room can obtained from the Parish Office.

FEES AND PAYMENT

The fees for a Funeral or Memorial Service at St John's vary according to what is desired by the family, but generally include: Celebrant, flowers, organist, document preparation, verger, and use of the building, Additional fees apply for operation of the audio visual system and musical rehearsals if required.

Payments for funeral services at St John's are most often arranged directly with the Funeral Director and a copy of the Invoice for our services are copied to the family.
