Joy Freier will speak on Restorative practice on Tuesday 22 October at 6:30pm at Georgio's Restaurant, cnr High St and Glenferried Rd.

Restorative practice aims to change the way our society responds to wrongdoing in schools, criminal justice, the workplace and elsewhere. Mrs Freier OAM previously served alongside her husband Archbishop Philip Freier, working as a teacher in several remote indigenous communities, including those on Cape York. Mrs Freier trained as a home economics and science teacher. Until last year she was the wellbeing coordinator at Coburg North Primary School.
